years of experience. Your analysis of the business model depends on optimizing two factors: 1)

percentage of Users that are qualified for and interested in the available job postings; and 2) the

raw amount of Job Posters and Users.

The purpose of your analysis will be to maximize the revenue of our business, while minimizing

costs.

Create a proposal to address this scenario.

Include as much of your thought process as possible. If you make any assumptions in this

challenge, please state them. Create your proposal in whatever format you are most comfortable

with.

Make sure to answer at least the following questions:

What would be your main considerations in creating a profitable and flexible roadmap?

How would you determine your marketing strategy and budget?

How would you address the project's variability and unknowns?
